DUKW
2 1/2 Ton GMC Amphibian Truck, World War II, 1941-1945

March 20, 2001
To My Family:
DUKW was the designation assigned by GMC, the manufacturer to the "Invention."
"D" indicated the year 1942
"U" indicated "Amphibian"
"K" indicated "front wheel drive"
"W" indicated "rear wheel drive"

I believe the DUKW was designed by Rod Stevens, a "racing boat designer" in 1942. I believe it was the Pentagon that asked him to work on it. He and his small group used the chassis of the New GMC 1 1/2 Ton Truck, which was developed in 1941, and in 38 days designed and produced the first DUKW in 1942. The Army didn't think too much of it to begin with and put it on the "back burner," but after a GREAT RESCUE of personnel of a grounded ship, it was a new ballgame.

I was the Company Commander of the 816th Amphibian Truck (DUKW) Company on Utah Beach. It was part of the 239th QM Battalion (TC) which also had the 815th, the 817th & the 818th Companies. We were part of the 1st Engineer

Special Brigade. The 816th and 50 DUKWS, a Wrecker, and a Jeep, Seven (7) Officers and 178 Enlisted Men. A DUKW was a 2 1/2 ton GMC Truck with a Hull like a boat, 3 axles, 6 wheels, a propeller, bilge pumps, a winch, and the ability to inflate and deflate its tires from inside the Cab. IT WAS SOMETHING! 2,000 DUKWS WERE USED IN THE INVASION.

The 816th Amphibian Truck (DUKW) Company was on Utah Beach from June 10, 1944 to November 10, 1944. We made 36,784 trips from ship to shore and transported 110,552 long tons of cargo from ship to shore. Then we went to Cherbourg and then to LeHavre, France before the Company CONVOYED to Southern France for deployment to the Pacific. Thank goodness the Pacific War ended before we boarded the ship!

There were 5 Allied Beaches on the Normandy Coast of Northern France. Utah and Omaha were American. Gold, Sword & Juno were British & Canadian.
